# About these terms and conditions

 In these terms and conditions, "you" means the HSBC Innovation Banking client named on the banking business payment card customer application pack. "We" means HSBC Innovation Banking. These terms and conditions govern your use of the virtual card Services (the "services") provided by HSBC Innovation Banking and should be read in conjunction with the banking terms and conditions and business charge card terms and conditions (which can be found at

www.hsbcinnovationbanking.com/regulations/terms-andconditions) and which are incorporated into, form part of, and where inconsistencies exist, override, these terms and conditions, unless expressly stated otherwise. It is therefore important that you read all of the relevant terms and conditions that form part of these terms and conditions carefully and thoroughly.

### Service Description

- A "virtual card" is a unique MasterCard® card number issued under your account (as defined in the business charge card terms and conditions). No physical card or 'plastic' is issued with a virtual card, but it will be associated to an identifier known as 'Real Card Number' ("RCN") to which multiple virtual cards may be associated.
- 3. Any references to a "card" or "charge card" in the business charge card terms and conditions shall, for the purposes of these terms and conditions, include a virtual card. You agree that, in addition to the provisions set out in these terms and conditions, the provisions of the business charge card terms and conditions and the banking terms and conditions shall apply to your use of a virtual card. It is important that your virtual cards are kept secure. Your responsibility to keep your virtual cards and account secure, and the steps we take to keep your account and transactions safe, are set out in the business charge card terms and conditions and the banking terms and conditions.
- 4. Where you request to receive the services by completing the banking business payment card customer application pack, you will be required to set up a user profile on the virtual card user interface that we will make available to you (the "virtual card Platform").
- 5. You are able to request a virtual card through a medium determined by HSBC Innovation Banking at any time, which shall include the virtual card platform or another application programming interface that we may make available to you.
- 6. You acknowledge that virtual cards are issued for a limited-time use for a specified amount with a specified expiration period. We will issue virtual cards to you on a single or multiple transaction ("multi-use") basis. You will be responsible for designating an individual with appropriate administration rights on the virtual card platform to determine any merchants or transaction limits for any virtual cards that you use.
- 7. You agree that if you select a virtual card on a multi-use basis then all other virtual cards associated with the RCN for that virtual card will also be used on a multi-use basis.
- Where you have requested a virtual card, we will issue a virtual card by electronically transmitting it to you or if requested by you, to a merchant accepting virtual cards.

- 9. You acknowledge and agree that you will not permit any third party to use your virtual card log in credentials or request a virtual card on your behalf, without our express prior consent.
- 10. We will generally issue virtual cards once we have received an authenticated instruction from you, but we will not be liable for any system delays. You should allow sufficient time when requesting the issuance of virtual cards to allow for such delays. In no event shall we be responsible for any late fees or other consequences, or damages caused by untimely receipt of payment by any payee when using virtual cards.
- You agree not to exceed the transaction limits we establish from time to time on your account or any card, including any virtual card.
- 12. All amounts issued on virtual cards will be posted upon issuance as advances to your account and shall be subject to the business charge card terms and conditions. There is no ability or right to stop a payment on a virtual card once that payment has been initiated, except as set out in the business charge card terms and conditions.
- 13. There is no charge for using the services. You acknowledge that all fees and charges applicable to card transactions (as defined in the business charge card terms and conditions) set out in your card tariff will also apply to all card transactions made using a virtual card.
- 14. When your virtual card programme set up is complete, we will enable online user access to the virtual card platform and you will be governed by the use of these services set out in these terms and conditions, the business charge card terms and conditions and the banking terms and conditions.
- If you are using MiVision, we may enable a service which allows your statements to be provided to you via MiVision and/or HSBCnet. If this service is not enabled, we will post your statements to you.

#### API

- 16. You agree and accept that if you have selected an API channel:
- a) HSBC Innovation Banking will grant a limited, revocable, non-exclusive, non-transferable, non-sublicensable license to access and use the (1) API and (2) the API integration documentation and certain other technology, documentation and materials as the parties may agree from time to time (collectively, the "API materials") solely for the purposes of developing the applications that will communicate and interoperate with the web site and related databases, servers or systems for HSBC Innovation Banking's banking products and services (the "API banking website");
- b) The API banking website, the API materials and all intellectual property rights therein, are the exclusive properties of HSBC Innovation Banking, its affiliates, service providers and its suppliers. There are no implied licenses granted;
- c) You acknowledge that the API materials and the API banking website contain valuable trade secrets of HSBC Innovation Banking and its suppliers, contractors, or agents. Accordingly, except as permitted under clause 16(a) above, you shall not use the API materials and API banking website for any purposes beyond the

scope of the license granted in clause 16(a). You shall not at any time, and shall not permit others to:

- copy, modify, or create derivative works of the API materials and the API banking website, in whole or in part;
- (2) rent, lease, lend, sell, sublicense, assign, distribute, publish, transfer, or otherwise make available the API materials and the API banking website;
- (3) remove any proprietary notices from the API materials and the API banking website;
- (4) use the API materials and the API banking website in any manner or for any purpose that infringes, misappropriates, or otherwise violates any intellectual property right or other right of any person, or that violates any applicable law;
- (5) combine or integrate the API materials and the API banking website with any software, technology, services, or materials not authorised by HSBC Innovation Banking;
- (6) design or permit your applications to disable, override, or otherwise interfere with any HSBC Innovation Bankingimplemented communications to end users, consent screens, user settings, alerts, warning, or the like;
- (7) reverse engineer, decompile, or disassemble the API materials or the API banking website; or otherwise attempt to gain access to any underlying code used to implement or deploy the API materials or the API banking website in whole or in part;
- (8) attempt to cloak or conceal your identity or the identity of your applications when requesting authorisation to use the API materials and the API banking website;
- (9) generate, in **our** reasonable opinion, unnecessary or excessive API messages or volumes of activity or make API messages above any API message rate limit **HSBC Innovation Banking** may set; or
- (10) engage in any fraudulent or illegal activity of any kind or use the API materials and the API banking website and any related documentation for any unlawful, threatening, harassing, obscene or infringing purpose; and
- d) Not withstanding anything to the contrary, HSBC Innovation Banking may, with or without notice, at any time change, suspend, or discontinue any aspect of the API materials or the API banking website. Without limiting the foregoing, HSBC Innovation Banking reserves the right, from time to time, without prior notice, to shut down any or all of the API materials and the API banking website for maintenance. HSBC Innovation Banking is not responsible or liable to you for such downtime.

## Use of Information

17. Where HSBC Innovation Banking collects or discloses any information relating to any of your employees or other representatives, we will use this information in accordance with our banking terms and conditions and our Privacy Policy (available at www.hsbcinnovationbanking.com/privacy-notice). If any of your representatives provide us with information on behalf of another individual, **you** confirm that they have the authority to do so and will provide that individual with a copy of our Privacy Policy.

# Liability

- 18. You agree that any liability arising in connection with your use of the services, including without limitation any breach by you or any other employee, agent or representative, shall be determined in accordance with clause 10 of the business charge card terms and conditions.
- 19. In accordance with clause 8 of Section 1 of the banking terms and conditions, we may carry out checks on certain payments made using your virtual card and we may contact you if we consider there to be any suspicious activity. If we do so, you agree to contact us as soon as possible and, if we ask you to do so, to cancel a virtual card through the virtual card platform to prevent further potential fraud. You acknowledge and agree that, if you do not cancel a virtual card through the virtual card platform when requested by us or if we are unable to contact you when we identify any suspicious activity, we may suspend or cancel an RCN or the use of your card in accordance with clause 1 of the business charge card terms and conditions.

### Variation

20. We may vary these terms and conditions at any time by giving you written notification of the changes at least 2 months before the change comes into effect (unless required sooner to comply with our legal or regulatory obligations) in accordance with clause 13.32 of Section 1 the banking terms and conditions (or in any other way which we reasonably think is likely to come to your attention and which satisfies our legal and regulatory obligations). We may provide you with less notice of a variation to these terms where the changes are favourable to you or neutral. You can object to any of these changes in accordance with clause 9 of the business charge card terms and conditions.

# Termination

21. You and HSBC Innovation Banking may terminate the contract incorporating these terms and conditions upon 14 days' notice to the other party. The contract incorporating these terms and conditions will automatically terminate on termination of our agreement under the banking terms and conditions or the business charge card terms and conditions.

# **Governing Law & Jurisdiction**

22. These **terms and conditions** (and any non-contractual obligations connected with them) are governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales. **You** irrevocably submit to the jurisdiction of the English courts, which have jurisdiction over any claims, disputes or other matters (including non-contractual claims or disputes) which may arise out of or in connection with these **terms and conditions**.
